
Persistent Falcine Sinus

- Normally it involutes after birth. If the <u>straight sinus</u> is absent or thrombosed then the falcine sinus may recanalise or persist.
- Frequently seen in association with a <u>vein of Galen</u>
 malformation.
- The falcine sinus should not be confused with the median prosencephalic vein (MPV) which is the 'aneurysmally' enlarged vein in the vein of Galen malformation and drains into the falcine sinus.
