

Nasolacrimal Duct Mucocele

- Congenital dacryocystocele
- Well-defined, cystic, unilateral or bilateral medial canthal mass in contiguity with enlarged bony NLD in newborn



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Axial CECT in an infant demonstrates a cystic mass → with an enhancing rim in the medial right orbit consistent with a mucocele. There is associated enlarged lacrimal sac fossa ↗. Note the normal left lacrimal sac fossa ↘.
